### INSIDE THE SERIES

The first recorded meeting of the school's in baseball took place in 1926. Catawba won both games of a home-and-home series that season. The teams would face off in 1927 then did not play again until the 1955 campaign. The schools played regularly through the 1972 season then resumed a yearly series in 1990.

The teams have met 76 times over the years with Catawba holding a 53-23 edge overall. The Crusaders won more than half their games in a stretch from 1963 until 1972, winning 12 straight in the series.

## HEAD COACH JIM GANTT

Jim Gantt is in his 19th season as head coach of the Catawba College baseball program. Under Gantt, Catawba has posted six 40+ win seasons and 15 straight 30+ win seasons. He has guided the Indians to eight regional appearances with a career record of 636-331.

Gantt led the Indians to their first College World Series appearance in 2012 and earned ABCA Southeast Region Coach of the Year honors. Gantt was named South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year for the seventh time in 2014 as he led Catawba to both the SAC regular season and tournament crowns.

In 2006, Catawba went 47-14 and won both the SAC regular season and tournament titles. The Indians were ranked as high as #2 in the nation that season.

Gantt also earned SAC Coach of the Year honors in 2004 after guiding the Indians to its first-ever berth in the NCAA II Regionals. He was named SAC Coach of the Year for the first time in 1999.

Catawba has produced 22 MLB Draft picks and 11 since 2008 with at least one players drafted in each year except for 2011.

## CURRENT PRO PLAYERS

### **\*Jerry Sands (Cleveland Indians)**

Sands has seen action in the majors with the the Los Angeles Dodgers and the Tampa Bay Rays. He broke in with the Dodgers during the 2011 season and played in 70 games over two seasons before being traded to the Boston Red Sox. After he just a few months with the Red Sox he was traded to the Pittsburgh Pirates. After being released by the Pirates he signed with Tampa Bay in 2014. Sands appeared in 12 games before a season-ending wrist injury. He was signed this off-season by Cleveland.

### **\*JJ Jankowski (Houston Astros)**

Jankowski pitched the 2014 season with the Corpus Cristi Hooks of the AA Midwest League. He went 5-6 with a 3.58 ERA and three saves. Jankowski was an All-Star in 2013 with Quad Cities. In three minor league seasons he is 12-7 with a 3.17 ERA and a dozen saves.

### **\*Nick Lomascolo (St, Louis Cardinals)**

Lomascolo helped the State College Spikes to the ShortSeason A New York-Penn League championship in 2014. The lefty went 1-1 with a 2.77 ERA and one save over 39 innings. In two seasons, Lomascolo is 3-4 with a 2.83 ERA and two saves. He has 87 strikeouts over 70 innings.

### **\*Chris Dula (Texas Rangers)**

Dula played with the Spokane Indians of the ShortSeason A Northwest League in 2014, helping the squad to the league championship series. Dula appeared in 13 games with 22 strikeouts over 16 and two-thirds innings.

### **\*Joe Watson (Texas Rangers)**

Watson spent his first minor league season with the Rookie Arizona Rangers. He appeared in just two games before being sidelined with an injury.

### **\*Paul Kronenfeld (Cincinnati Reds)**

Kronenfeld played in 44 games for the Rookie Arizona Reds. He batted .234 with a pair of homers and 21 RBI.
