INSIDE THE SERIES

Catawba and Lincoln Memorial have met 140 times on the diamond with Catawba holding a 91-49 edge all-time. The Indians are 36-25 in games at Wilson and won 5-3 at Barton last year.

The teams first met in 1926 when Barton was known as Atlantic Christian. The Bulldogs won both games that season, but Catawba went on to take 33 of the next 34 meetings. The teams twice met in NAIA District 26 Tournaments with the Bulldogs winning both match-ups.

HEAD COACH JIM GANTT

Jim Gantt is in his 19th season as head coach of the Catawba College baseball program. Under Gantt, Catawba has posted six 40+ win seasons and 15 straight 30+ win seasons. He has guided the Indians to eight regional appearances with a career record of 636-331.

Gantt led the Indians to their first College World Series appearance in 2012 and earned ABCA Southeast Region Coach of the Year honors. Gantt was named South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year for the seventh time in 2014 as he led Catawba to both the SAC regular season and tournament crowns.

In 2006, Catawba went 47-14 and won both the SAC regular season and tournament titles. The Indians were ranked as high as #2 in the nation that season.

Gantt also earned SAC Coach of the Year honors in 2004 after guiding the Indians to its first-ever berth in the NCAA II Regionals. He was named SAC Coach of the Year for the first time in 1999.

SECOND STRAIGHT SAC SWEEP

With its sweep of Lincoln Memorial last weekend, Catawba made it two straight three-game sweeps in league competition which vaulted the Indians to the top of the standings. Catawba has currently won 17 of 18 games with the loss coming 1-0 to Newberry. The Indians also had a 1-0 loss just prior to starting the recent run.

ALBERTSON ON A HOT STREAK

Junior transfer Will Albertson had a six game stretch that ended Sunday where he at one point had hits in 20 of 22 at bats. During that run he set a school record by reaching base in 14 straight plate appearances. He had two four hit games, two three hit games and one five hit game. He connected on three home runs during his five-hit game which tied a school record.

HOUSTON GETS SAC AND REGION PLAYER OF WEEK HONORS

Blake Houston was tabbed not only as the SAC Player of the week on M/10, but also took home NCBWA All-Southeast Region Player of the Week accolades. The senior went 8-for-15 (.571) at the plate in the four wins and collected nine RBI. He had multi-hit efforts in the three of the four games with three hits and four RBI in the opener with Lenoir-Rhyne.

WHARTON'S STREAK STOPPED

T.J. Wharton had a 14-game hitting streak snapped against Lenoir-Rhyne. Paul Kronenfeld had the most recent longest streak with a 20-game streak last season.

ON TOP EARLY

Catawba has scored first in 11 of 20 games this season and have an 11-1 record when plating the first run. The Indians have also been outstanding at holding leads. Catawba is 16-1 when leading after six innings, losing only to Carson-Newman after a pair of late inning errors. Under Gantt, Catawba is an amazing 517-34 when holding a lead after six innings.

MAKING PRODUCTIVE OUTS

In the 11-0 win over Davis & Elkins on Monday, six of Catawba's runs came on outs. The Indians hit four sacrifice flies and also plated two runs on ground outs.

BROOKS TAKES SAC HONOR

Craig Brooks earned SAC Pitcher of the Week honos on M/3 after posting a pair of wins during the week. He got his week started with a no-hitter on Monday against Brevard. He followed that up with a win at Newberry, tossing eight innings and surrendering two earned runs on three hits with eight strikeouts.

WHARTON HAS BIG FEBRUARY

Senior T.J. Wharton had a huge February at the plate, hitting an even .500. The senior was 30-for-60 with five double and two home runs. He knocked in 14 runs and scored 14. He ranked among league leaders in average, on-base percentage and slugging percentage.

BROOKS TWIRLS NO-HITTER

Catawba senior Craig Brooks threw just the sixth no-hitter in school history against Brevard on Monday. In the first game of the doubleheader, Brooks went the complete seven-innings, walking three, hitting one and fanning six. Catawba's last no-hitter was a combined effort in 2003 with the last complete game no-hitter coming in 1988.

STILLMAN SWEEP

Catawba swept its three-game series at Stillman on Feb. 13 and 14. The Indians reached double digits in runs in all three wins and reached 20 runs in the finale, marking the second time this year Catawba has scored 20+ runs in a game.

INDIANS SALVAGE FINAL GAME OF OPENING SAC SERIES

Connor Johnson improved to 2-0 and Ryan McClintock notched his first save as Caawba topped Carson-Newman 6-3 to take game three of the opening league series. Catawba lost two one-run games to start the series.

RICHARDSON GRABS SAC HONORS

Shortstop Dylan Richardson grabbed the initial conference Player of the Week honors after he batted .727 with 10 RBI and a pair of home runs in Catawba's opening series of the year. The junior helped Catawba win two of three games, hitting a grand slam and collecting seven RBI in the 27-7 win to begin the season.

SEASON-OPENING BLOWOUT
