CATAWBA - The Indians return to the regionals for the third straight year and for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Catawba has qualified both years since moving into the Southeast Region from the South Region. The Indians advance to the South Region final game in both 2006 and 2008.

Catawba has won all four of its previous opening games in the regionals. Catawba defeated top-seeded Rollins 4-3 in 2004, scoring a run in the top of the ninth. In 2006, the Indians rallied with a run in the bottom of the ninth and another in the 10th for a -8 win over Florida Southern. In 2008, Catawba scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth to take a 5-4 victory over Florida Tech. Last season, the Indians claimed a 7-5 win over Georgia College & State.

Offensively, NC State transfer Wade Moore has set the table. He leads the team in nearly all offensive categories and was batting nearly .500 into mid-April. He has swatted 16 home runs and scored 77 runs entering regional play. One of the other offensive stars has been Craig Lyerly. Although his school record hitting streak was snapped at 39 games early in the season, the senior has reached base with either a hit or walk in all 51 games running his astounding streak to 86 straight games reaching base safely.

On the mound, Nathan Furr was named league Pitcher of the Year, going 6-0, and should be ready to go after a late-season arm injury. Trevor Mullins was named all-conference and has an 8-2 mark, while freshman Nick Lomascolo has stepped in to post a 7-2 record with a 3.44 ERA. Wil Huneycutt, a first team All-SAC pick has come out of the pen in 26 games and went 5-1 with four saves and a 2.39 ERA.

HEAD COACH JIM GANTT

Jim Gantt is in his 14th season as head coach of the Catawba College baseball program. Under Gantt, Catawba has posted a dozen 30+ win seasons. He was named the 2008 South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year after guiding

Catawba to its fourth title in five years.

Gantt was named the 2006 SAC Coach of the Year after the Tribe went 47-14, winning both the SAC regular season and tournament titles and advancing to the NCAA II South Region Championship game. The Indians were ranked as high as #2 in the nation.

Gantt also earned SAC Coach of the Year honors in 2004 after guiding the Indians to a then school record 42 wins, including its first-ever berth in the NCAA II Regionals. In 2005, Catawba won the SAC title and went 35-19. The 1997 squad, his first as head coach, equaled a then second most win total with 32. Gantt also led the Indians to the 2002 SAC Tournament title and was named SAC Coach of the Year for the first time in 1999.
